### **Funding Period and Award Amount**

June 15, 2008 – June 14, 2010

One \$100,000 Award

**Eligibility Criteria:** Applicants must have completed no more than five years of their first faculty appointment by June 15, 2008. The applicant's primary faculty appointment must be at one of the eligible Schools of Public Health or Tufts University Public Health and Professional Degree Programs. Up to three applications from each of the following four schools/programs may be submitted:

- Boston University School of Public Health
- Harvard University School of Public Health
- Tufts University Public Health and Professional Degree Programs
- University of Massachusetts Amherst School of Public Health and Health Sciences
