The Hilda and Preston Davis Foundation Awards Program for Eating Disorders Research

Program Overview:

The Davis Foundation Awards Program for Eating Disorders Research supports innovative, clinically-relevant research that seeks to understand the underlying biology of eating disorders, including anorexia nervosa and bulimia nervosa, and to improve patient care. These awards are designed to build a strong scientific workforce dedicated to understanding the etiology of eating disorders and therapeutic development.



The Program provides two types of Awards, that respectively fund **Senior Postdoctoral Fellows** and **Junior Faculty Investigators**, working in non-profit academic, medical and research institutions in the United States. All applicants must hold a Ph.D., M.D., or comparable degree and U.S. citizenship is not required.

The Davis Foundation Awards Program employs a two-stage Review process. In the first stage submitted Letters of Intent (LOI) are reviewed. Based on ranking, applicants will be invited to submit Full Proposals to be reviewed for funding consideration.

Scheduled Funding Period: May 1, 2019 – April 30, 2021

Senior Postdoctoral Fellowship

Award: Two-year senior postdoctoral fellowship awards (~\$110,000), adjusted based upon awardee experience at the current NIH fellowship levels.

Applicants must have completed at least three (3) years and no more than seven (7) years of full-time postdoctoral research experience at the time of funding.

Junior Faculty Investigator Award

Award: The funding level of the two-year Junior Faculty Award will be \$200,000 USD (\$100,000 per year inclusive of 5% indirect costs).

Applicants must have a full-time independent faculty appointment and their first faculty appointment must have been received no more than five (5) years prior to the time of funding.
