The Robert E. Leet and Clara Guthrie Patterson Trust was established in 1980 for the advancement of medical science, particularly research "relating to human diseases, their causes and relief."

The Patterson Trust will provide support to mentored investigators conducting clinical research with a focus on patient-oriented or translational laboratory research.

The Program will help the Trust to pursue its mission by providing Applicants with the opportunity to demonstrate creativity and explore opportunities that may promote careers in clinical research. Pilot and preliminary studies are encouraged.

Award Amount:

Two-year Fellowships ranging from \$90,000 - \$110,000

Eligibility:

- Work in a non-profit academic, medical or research institution in the states of Connecticut (CT) or New Jersey (NJ)
- Be mentored by a senior scientist with an active research program where the Applicant will be conducting research
- Applicants may not hold a career development award, including an NIH K Award or equivalent
- Applicants with clinical responsibilities may have worked no more than six years since residency training
- Applicants without clinical responsibilities must have a minimum of three years but no more than five years of full-time postdoctoral research
- U.S. citizenship or visa documentation is not required
