

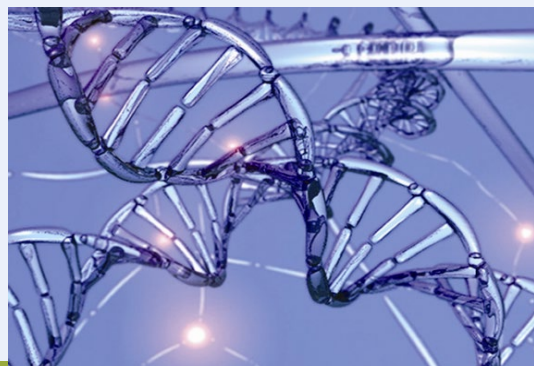

ELIGIBILITY

Clinical/Health Services Research

- No more than 6 years of employment since completion of residency training or 3 - 6 years of postdoctoral employment by October 1, 2022.
- M.D., D.M.D., M.D./Ph.D., Ph.D., or comparable degree and engaged in mentored postdoctoral research in an academic or medical research institution in the state of Massachusetts.
- At least one primary, peer reviewed research article from their postdoctoral work.
- Research involving human subjects that is:
 - 1) Patient-oriented research
 - 2) Epidemiological and behavioral studies
 - 3) Outcomes and health services research
