The Noonan Research Fund supports original clinical and service system research and demonstration projects designed to improve the quality of life for children with disabilities relevant to the Noonan focus.

Eligibility Requirements:

- Applicants must hold a position within a non-profit organization or institution.
- Project must address the target population age range of birth through 23 years old.
- The majority of research subjects must be within the Fund's geographic area of interest (Refer to list of eligible cities and towns in Application Guidelines).
- Neither an academic faculty position nor an advanced degree is required for eligibility.
